Home to more than 180 live music venues, from the historic **Ryman Auditorium** and the **Grand Ole Opry** to independent venues such as **The Bluebird Cafe** and **3rd & Lindsley**, there is a unique experience for everyone in Music City.

With more music museums than anywhere in the world, visitors can experience the rich history of music from any genre at the **National Museum of African American Music** or the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum**. Just west of downtown, visitors can hear the legendary sound recordings of Dolly Parton and Elvis Presley at **Historic RCA Studio B**, located on **Music Row**.

In recent years, there has been an evolution in both the quality of hotel rooms and quantity of rooms—from boutique to 5-star properties such as the **Four Seasons Nashville**, the **Conrad Nashville** and the **1 Hotel Nashville**—which has broadened Nashville's appeal and the visitor's experience.

The culinary scene is also hotter than ever with award winning chefs and acclaimed restaurants leaving their mark in Music City and making Nashville a premier culinary destination with **over 300 new restaurants** opening in the past three years. Nashville has also become a hot bed for breweries and distilleries while southern staples such as Hot Chicken, meat-and-three, and Tennessee pork barbecue remain deeply embedded in the city's food culture.

Nashville is a year-round sports destination with four professional teams. In the fall, the excitement starts on Sundays with the city's NFL team the **Tennessee Titans** who are set to move into a new stadium in 2027 on the East Bank. The action continues downtown at **Bridgestone Arena**, home to the NHL's **Nashville Predators**. Nashville is also home to MLS team, the **Nashville Soccer Club**, that play at the largest soccer specific stadium—**GEODIS Park**—in the United States and Canada. The city also claims the **Nashville Sounds**, a MiLB team that recorded the highest total attendance of any team in the MiLB this past year.

Growing at a sensational pace, there's something new to experience at every corner in Music City.




10 THINGS YOU CAN ONLY DO IN NASHVILLE

- 1 Hear the Music Where Music Lives:** We're proud of the title "Music City" – nowhere else can you hear such diverse sounds as Americana, country, rockabilly, jazz, blues, classical, gospel, and rock n' roll. In fact, there are over 180 live music venues in Nashville.
- 2 Hit the Hall:** Kick off your Nashville experience with a day at the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum. The world's largest popular music museum offers ever-changing exhibits featuring the legends of country music past and today's hottest stars.
- 3 Ride the Row:** Take a tour of Music Row and visit historic RCA Studio B, the famous recording studio where Elvis recorded over 250 songs. Roy Orbison, Dolly Parton, Everly Brothers, Eddy Arnold, and many more recorded classic hits here. Not surprisingly, the heartbeat of Music City is driven by music – from country to classical. Tours of RCA Studio B depart daily from the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum.
- 4 Visit the Home Of the Greek Gods:** In Nashville's Centennial Park, you'll find the world's only full-scale reproduction of the ancient Parthenon in Athens, Greece. The Parthenon houses an art gallery and museum as well as sculptor Alan LeQuire's Athena Parthenos. Standing at almost 42 feet in height, Athena is the tallest indoor sculpture in the Western world.
- 5 Hear Nashville's Newest Sound:** Honoring musicians from stars to studio players that represent all genres of music, the Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum is housed in the Nashville Municipal Auditorium. From Hank Williams, Sr. to the Red Hot Chili Peppers, Motown to Southern Rock – there is truly something of interest to everyone. Discover the central role African Americans have played in shaping and creating all genres of American music at the National Museum of African American Music (NMAAM). NMAAM integrates history and interactive technology to share the untold story of more than 50 music genres and sub-genres.
- 6 Take In a Songwriters-In-the-Round Show:** One of the most unique ways to hear music in Nashville is at a songwriters show. Typically called a "writers night," songwriters are put somewhere they are not used to being – in the spotlight. Several singer/songwriters will play "in-the-round" as they sit on stage accompanied only by a microphone, a guitar, and their immense talent. These shows can be found in small, intimate clubs all over town, including the famous Bluebird Cafe in Green Hills and Downtown's The Listening Room Cafe.
- 7 Visit the Ryman Auditorium:** The Ryman Auditorium, also called the "Mother Church of Country Music," has had artists as diverse as Jon Bon Jovi and Patsy Cline perform on its legendary stage since 1892. You can take a backstage tour and record your own song in the Ryman studio.
- 8 Take a Timeless Journey:** The stars of the Grand Ole Opry take the stage every Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday night with guest appearances by the biggest names in music. With 95 years of history, the Opry is the world's longest-running broadcast and shows no signs of slowing down.
- 9 Salute:** Three U.S. Presidents called Tennessee home – Andrew Jackson, James K. Polk, and Andrew Johnson. You can revisit the past at Andrew Jackson's Hermitage: The People's President. Polk is buried on the grounds of the historic State Capitol building in downtown Nashville.
- 10 Visit Honky Tonk Highway:** Ole Red, AJ's Good Time Bar, Whiskey Bent Saloon, Robert's Western World, and more are all experts at serving up cool longnecks and hot country music. You never know who you'll see in these Lower Broadway clubs in the shadow of the Ryman. Willie Nelson, Kris Kristofferson, Gretchen Wilson, Dierks Bentley, and other stars began their careers on Lower Broadway.
