Home to more than **250** live music venues, from the historic Ryman Auditorium and the Grand Ole Opry to independent venues such as The Bluebird Cafe and 3rd & Lindsley, Music City offers a unique experience for everyone.

With more music museums than anywhere in the world, visitors can explore the rich history of music of all genres at the **National Museum of African American Music**, **Musicians Hall of Fame & Museum**, or the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum**. Just west of downtown, visitors can hear the legendary sound recordings of Dolly Parton and Elvis Presley at **Historic RCA Studio B**, located on Music Row.

Nashville's hotel scene continues to grow and evolve, offering visitors even more ways to stay in the heart of Music City. From boutique gems like **Noelle Hotel** and **Waymore's Guest House** to world class luxury at the **Four Seasons Nashville**, **The Joseph**, **A Luxury Collection Hotel**, Nashville and the historic **Hermitage Hotel**, the city's expanding collection of hotel properties adds to the unforgettable experience of visiting Nashville.

Music City's culinary scene is hotter than ever, with award-winning chefs and acclaimed restaurants leaving their mark through bold flavors and unforgettable dining experiences across the city. With more than 500 new restaurants opening since 2019 and the MICHELIN Guide arriving in the American South, Nashville is establishing itself as a premier destination for food lovers. Nashville has also become a mecca for breweries and distilleries, while iconic southern staples such as **Hot Chicken**, **meat-and-three**, and **Tennessee pork barbecue** remain deeply embedded in the city's food culture.

Nashville is a year-round sports destination with four professional teams. In the fall, the excitement starts on Sundays with the city's NFL team, the **Tennessee Titans**, who are set to move into a new stadium on the East Bank in 2027. The action continues downtown at **Bridgestone Arena**, where the NHL **Nashville Predators** take the ice in "Smashville". Nashville also has the largest soccer-specific stadium in the United States and Canada—**GEODIS Park**, home to the MLS team, the **Nashville Soccer Club**. The city also claims the **Nashville Sounds**, an MiLB team that recorded the highest total attendance of any team in the MiLB this past year. This past year the Sounds finished Top 5 in Triple-A attendance for the fifth consecutive season







10 THINGS YOU CAN ONLY DO IN NASHVILLE

1 Hear the Music Where Music Lives: We're proud of the title "Music City" – nowhere else can you hear such diverse sounds as Americana, country, rockabilly, jazz, blues, classical, gospel, and rock n' roll. In fact, there are **more than 250 live music venues** in Nashville.

2 Hit the Hall: Kick off your Nashville experience with a day at the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum**. The world's largest popular music museum offers ever-changing exhibits featuring the legends of country music past and today's hottest stars.

3 Ride the Row: Take a tour of Music Row and visit historic **RCA Studio B**, the famous recording studio where Elvis recorded over 200 songs. Roy Orbison, Dolly Parton, The Everly Brothers, Eddy Arnold, and many more recorded classic hits here.

4 Visit the Home of The Greek Gods: In Nashville's **Centennial Park**, you'll find the world's only full-scale reproduction of the ancient **Parthenon** in Athens, Greece.

5 Hear Nashville's Newest Sound: The long-awaited **National Museum of African American Music** is a 56,000-square-foot facility that encourages visitors to discover the central role African Americans have played in shaping and creating all genres of American music, from classical to country to jazz and hip hop.

6 Take in A Songwriters-In-The-Round Show: One of the most unique ways to hear music in Nashville is at a songwriters' show. Several singer/songwriters will play "in-the-round" as they sit on stage accompanied only by a microphone, a guitar, and their immense talent.

7 Visit the Ryman Auditorium: The **Ryman Auditorium**, also called the "Mother Church of Country Music," has had artists as diverse as Jon Bon Jovi and Patsy Cline perform on its legendary stage since 1892.

8 Take A Timeless Journey: The stars of the **Grand Ole Opry** take the famous six-foot circle of wood and perform every Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday night. With over 90 years of history, the Opry is the world's longest-running broadcast.

9 Salute: Three U.S. Presidents called Tennessee home: Andrew Jackson, James K. Polk, and Andrew Johnson. You can revisit the past at **Andrew Jackson's Hermitage: Home of the People's President**. Polk is buried on the grounds of the historic State Capitol building in downtown Nashville.

10 Visit Nashville's Neon Neighborhood: Tootsie's Orchid Lounge, Legends Corner, The Second Fiddle, The Stage, Layla's Bluegrass Inn, Robert's Western World, and more are all experts at serving up cool longnecks and hot country music. Willie Nelson, Kris Kristofferson, Dierks Bentley, and others began their careers on **Lower Broadway**.
