



Mid-Day

Enjoy lunch on your own inside the international food court at the **Nashville**Farmers' Market or visit L & L Market, a new one-stop destination for local shopping and cuisine.

After lunch, explore the **Tennessee State Museum** and just steps away the **Bicentennial Capitol Mall State Park**.

Afternoon

Learn why Nashville was once known as "the Athens of the South" at the world's only full scale replica of the ancient Greek temple, **The Parthenon**, located inside the newly revitalized Centennial Park. Hear about the history at **Belle Meade Historic Site & Winery**, one of the largest thoroughbred horse farms in the South with over 5,400 acres. Then visit the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum** for a self-guided tour.

Mid-Day

Enjoy lunch downtown on your own before experiencing the Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum or Ryman Auditorium, known as the "Mother Church of Country Music". Next, test your cooking skills with a hands-on class at the newly renovated Goo Goo Chocolate Co., home of Nashville's Goo Goo Cluster candy bar.

Evening

Dine at Opry Backstage Grill, Santa
Fe Cattle Co., Paula Deen's Family
Kitchen, or enjoy free time and dinner
at Opry Mills. Include a visit to Madame
Tussauds Nashville before catching
a show at the Grand Ole Opry –
Nashville's must-see attraction and the
world's longest-running live radio show.
Conclude your day with an

Opry Backstage Tour.

Free Time

If you've got some free time on your hands, we've got you covered.

Explore the city at your own pace with **Gray Line** or **Old Town Trolley Tours** hop-on/hop-off. You will stop at over 15 locations throughout Music City, with opportunities to shop, eat, drink, be entertained, and much more!

If you have a full day, take the scenic ride down to **Jack Daniel's Distillery**, the oldest registered distillery in the United States and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visitors receive personally-guided tours of the distillery and observe the famous whiskey-making process.
