Mid-Day

Step aboard the **General Jackson Showboat**, one of the largest showboats in the country! Your taste buds will flourish with the flavors of the South during the midday cruise followed by a country music variety show. **OR...**

Enjoy lunch on your own inside the international food court at the **Nashville Farmers' Market** or visit **L & L Market**, a new one-stop destination for local shopping and cuisine.

After lunch, explore the **Tennessee State Museum** and just steps away the **Bicentennial Capitol Mall State Park**.

Afternoon

Learn why Nashville was once known as "the Athens of the South" at the world's only full scale replica of the ancient Greek temple, **The Parthenon**, located inside the newly revitalized Centennial Park. Hear about the history at **Belle Meade Historic Site & Winery**, one of the largest thoroughbred horse farms in the South with over 5,400 acres. DAY THREE

Morning

Be a **Star for a Day!** as the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum** brings it all together in this very unique package offering. Begin with a tour and group recording session at **Historic RCA Studio B**, where music legends such as Elvis and Dolly recorded timeless songs. Then visit the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum** for a self-guided tour.

Mid-Day

Enjoy lunch downtown on your own before experiencing the **Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum** or **Ryman Auditorium**, known as the "Mother Church of Country Music". Next, test your cooking skills with a hands-on class at the newly renovated **Goo Goo Chocolate Co.**, home of Nashville's Goo Goo Cluster candy bar.

Evening

Dine at **Opry Backstage Grill**, **Santa Fe Cattle Co.**, **Paula Deen's Family Kitchen**, or enjoy free time and dinner at **Opry Mills**. Include a visit to **Madame Tussauds Nashville** before catching a show at the **Grand Ole Opry** – Nashville's must-see attraction and the world's longest-running live radio show. Conclude your day with an **Opry Backstage Tour**.

Free Time

If you've got some free time on your hands, we've got you covered.

Explore the city at your own pace with **Gray Line** or **Old Town Trolley Tours** hop-on/hop-off. You will stop at over 15 locations throughout Music City, with opportunities to shop, eat, drink, be entertained, and much more!

If you have a full day, take the scenic ride down to **Jack Daniel's Distillery**, the oldest registered distillery in the United States and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visitors receive personally-guided tours of the distillery and observe the famous whiskey-making process.
